

#### Membership Renewal Notices

There is a proposed ASPE Bylaw change coming up for discussion and vote at the National Convention next month in Long Beach, California. What it amounts to is that if passed by the delegates, membership renewal notices will be sent out roughly three months earlier than they are now. If Society hasn't received payment before your membership expiration date, you will be dropped from the membership roster. According to Society, getting the notices out earlier streamlines the process for them, lessens the workload, saves money, makes it easier to maintain an accurate membership roster, tastes great and is less filling. I'll let you know more about this exciting proposal after the convention (yawn).

#### Here's how I imagine it works now for most of you:

Society sends out a dues invoice a couple of months prior to your membership expiration date. You open it and think to yourself, *"Is it that time of year again? I should send this back right away."* and you throw it on top of the pile of mail on your desk. A number of weeks go by and you get your second notice. You intuitively recognize it as being a second notice mainly because you can read the red *"Second Notice"* through the envelope window. You place the envelope unopened on top of the pile of mail on your desk as you reach over to answer your phone.

A few weeks later (during the first week of the month) Society sends out the updated Chapter Roster and Delinquent Member List to every Chapter V.P. Membership, (including yours truly). Lo and behold, your name is now on the Boston Chapter Delinquent Member list (who would have guessed!). I review the list, recognize the same old dozen or so names from last year, and forward the roster and delinquent list to the head of our Membership Retention Committee; Joan "The Enforcer" Panora.
