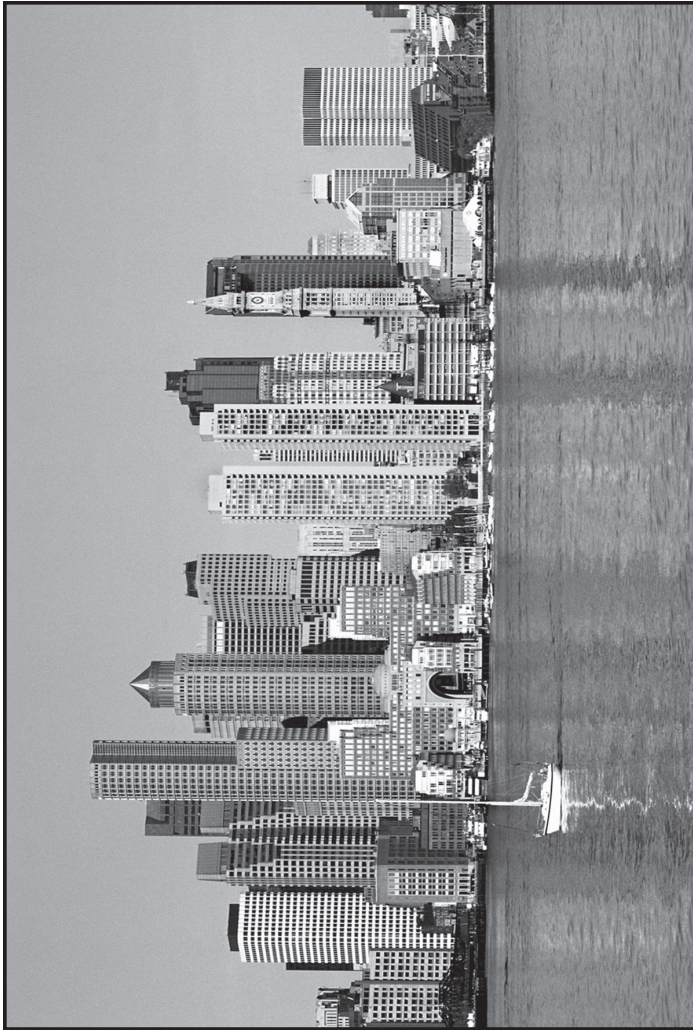

Technical Report

As plumbing professionals we are constantly making decisions that affect the health and well being of society. Generally our decisions are based on sound engineering principals, codes and empirical experiences. If you are fortunate enough to work in a nurturing office environment you can present your choices to your colleagues for cooperative feed-back. The experience of peers is invaluable, most especially when it comes to dealing with the interpretation of codes. This method is ideal and does help to produce a better product.

The question is do you work in an open cooperative environment? You may not have that environment in your office but you do have it with the Boston Chapter of ASPE. As a technical network we are there for each other. For example, the Boston Chapter does have resources tasked with trying to stay in communication with the State Plumbing Board. On many occasions variances are granted and policies are changed that have an impact on all of us. The entire plumbing community does not always have access to the latest information and I am encouraging you to reach out with your issues. You may be surprised to discover that the same issue you have dealt with is also an issue with a fellow Plumbing Design Engineer. Arguably, we have had success in the past with distributing information - credit to Manuel Garcia, P.E., C.P.D. who frequently writes articles that are published in this monthly newsletter. As always there is a request for issues that can be vetted out and brought to the board.

Our issues do not have to be just specific to one area. There are many issues that do impact all of us whether it is a local or national issue. Your participation is strongly encouraged. We can strengthen our decisions by communicating with one another. We are a professional engineer society that can make our chapter a fertile and effective organization.

A few reminders of upcoming ASPE events:

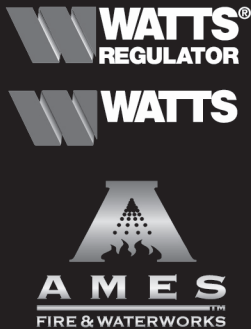

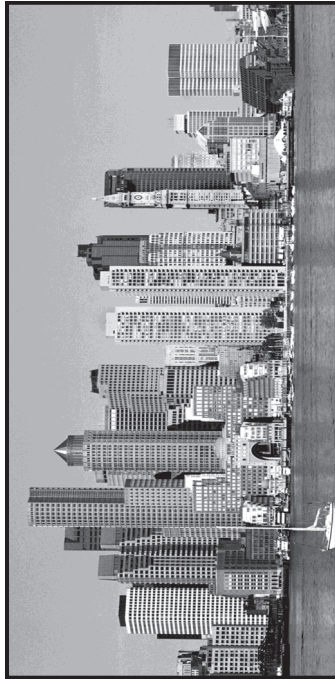

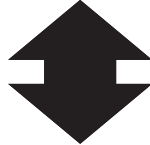
